

Grevillea House. Make yourself at home

SA Country Carers have been providing overnight respite accommodation at Grevillea House for ten years. The house is named after the large grevillea tree that stands tall on the front lawn.

From the outside, Grevillea House looks like other homes on Victoria Street in Clare, the house contains the same features as any other home. There are two sitting rooms with televisions, kitchen, laundry and four bedrooms.

What is unique about the house is that each bedroom has its own ensuite, with shower, toilet and hand basin. This means that everyone has their own space and privacy. Whilst staying with



us at Grevillea House, clients are encouraged to make themselves at home, and to enjoy their surrounds. There will often be an afternoon movie playing in the lounge, board games being played in the dining room, and day trips to regional towns. Our most popular outings include trips to the historical mining town of Burra, Gladstone, Laura and to the Barossa.

Grevillea house is open twice per month, for four days mid week. The house is staffed 24 hours during this time. Carers are most welcome to stay at Grevillea House with the person they care for, and enjoy all we have to offer. Or you may prefer to have a total break and leave the care of your loved one to our experienced staff.

Our fees are \$49.50 per person per night (including GST). This includes all main meals and activities during your stay, including



meals at hotels or cafes during outings. If you or your loved one is looking for a break, please call our Respite Team and discuss eligibility to attend Grevillea House and experience a home away from home in the beautiful Clare Valley.

EASY CHOCOLATE

- * 1 X 400g tin of sweetened condensed milk
- * 100g butter cubed
- * 250g firmly packed brown sugar
- * 1 TB spoon golden syrup,
- + 100g chopped dark chocolate.

Grease 20cm square pan with butter, line with baking paper. Place all ingredients (except chocolate) in heat proof bowl, cook uncovered for 10-12 minutes, stirring every 2 minutes, on med-high bubbles (70%) until appear over whole surface. Add chocolate until well combined and smooth. Pour into prepared pan. Place in fridge for 1 hour or until firm.


