2016 Quality Review

We are fast approaching the scheduled 23 -24 May 2016 Quality Review! The services that are being audited are the Commonwealth Home Support Respite Programmes (CHSP) – namely Flexible, Centre-Based and Cottage respite. With the last newsletter we sent out a separate letter to CHSP eligible clients outlining the process.

If you are a client receiving any of these services and wish to participate, you can register your interest on 1300 686 405. Or you can contact the Quality Agency directly on 08 8217 6000 or by email sa_nt@aacqa.gov.au Participation is voluntary and would include talking to the auditors either in our office in Blanche Street Clare or via the telephone at a pre arranged time to answer questions about your service. You can always ask someone else to speak with the review team on your behalf if you wish – like a relative or a friend.

Included with this newsletter is a copy of the Department of Health's Charter of Rights and Responsibilities for Home Care.

This is an updated version for CHSP to the one you were provided with upon registering with SA Country Carers.

Overnight respite for eligible clients with disabilities

SA Country Carers provides overnight and weekend respite accommodation at Grevillea House for people under and over 18 living with a disability. The house is unique in that each bedroom has its own ensuite, with shower, toilet and hand basin. This means that everyone has their own space and privacy. For clients registered with Disability SA, there is a small client contribution. NDIS participants will have a pre-approved quoted amount included in their NDIS plan. If the client contribution is not included in the plan, there will be a a small cost associated for the respite stay. Referrals for clients registered with Disability SA must come from Disability SA. Please discuss this with your case worker. NDIS participant referrals can come from NDIS, your leading organisation or if self managed, the referral can come from yourself.



250 gm. Large Pasta Shells

- 1 Table Spoon Olive Oil
- 1 Medium Brown Onion, thinly sliced
- 1 Lg Red Capsicum, thinly sliced
- 2 Garlic Cloves crushed
- 2 X 400gm cans diced tomatoes
- 1/2 cup Pitted Green Olives chopped
- 2 X 185 gm Cans of Tuna in Oil, drained and flaked
- 3/4 Cup Grated Mozzarella Cheese
- 1/3 Cup Grated Parmesan Cheese

Pre-heat oven to 220 C, (200 if fan forced).
Lightly grease an 8 cup capacity Baking Dish.
Cook pasta in saucepan of boiling salted water
(follow packet direction until tender) drain

Mean while, heat oil in large frying pan over medium heat, add onion and capsicum, cook stirring for 5 minutes until softened, add garlic, cook stirring for 1 minute

Add tomato's, bring to the boil, reduce heat to medium, cook for 10 minutes or until sauce has thickened, add pasta, olives and tuna, toss to combine, add pepper, spoon in to dish, top with cheeses. Bake for 12-15 minutes, until cheese is golden and serve.
